## Eavesdropping on Jesus

"I ask not only on behalf of these but also on behalf of those who believe in me through their word, that they may all be one. As you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. (John 17:20-21)

In the Gospel of John chapter 17, we have the opportunity to eavesdrop on Jesus as He prays to His father. It's the longest prayer of Jesus recorded in the New Testament, and what makes John 17 so wonderful is that we get to see what's important to Jesus. In this intimate conversation between the Son and the Father, we get to peek into the very heart of God. After saying this prayer, Jesus crossed the Kidron Valley where He was betrayed and arrested.

After praying for Himself and the disciples, Jesus prays for those who believe in me through their word. That's us, you and me. Jesus had us in mind when He was speaking to His Father. Can you imagine that – Jesus putting you on His prayer list? Jesus loved you enough to pray for you and He's still praying for you, even this very day. Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and he is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us. (Romans 8:34)

Jesus did not pray that you would merely be happy or even that you would escape grief. He prayed that you would have the same joy that the Father had given Him; a divine joy, a joy that

Yet no, instead He asked that His followers remain united in their love for one another. Jesus wants us to understand that it is spiritually impossible to love God but not love others.

Let us pray: Holy God, we marvel at the mystery of Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection. We are awed by His obedience, astonished by the depth of His love for us and amazed by the display of your power over the forces of sin and death. You are a God of wonders. Your miraculous power continues to work in our lives and in our world. Set our hearts aflame and open our eyes that we may recognize your presence in every person, in every situation, in every place. Amen.


